### **OVERVIEW**



Prof. Dr. Riaz Ahmed is a renowned Consultant Orthopaedic Surgeon working as Dean Orthopaedics, Neurosurgery & Trauma, Head of Orthopaedics, Rawalpindi Medical University & Allied Teaching Hospitals, Rawalpindi, Pakistan. He is a fellow of prestigious International Orthopaedic organizations like Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow, American College of Surgeons and International College of Surgeons (USA). Due to his untiring efforts, the Department of Orthopaedics, Benazir Bhutto Hospital, Rawalpindi was recognized for Pakistan Orthopaedic Association (POA) Trauma Fellowship on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2017. Uptil now 5 Orthopaedic surgeons have completed their POA Trauma Fellowship.

The standard of training has been such that highest number of residents have cleared FCPS and MS Orthopaedic Surgery examination under his mentorship. His devotion to research has been such that under his leadership, the Department of Orthopaedics won International and National research awards. One International award at the Asia Pacific Orthopaedic Association Meeting, Putrajaya, Malaysia (2017) and the other at European Federation of Orthopaedics & Traumatology (EFORT), Spain (2018). Two National research awards awarded by the President of Pakistan at the 1st Pakistan Annual Health Research Conference held in Islamabad, Pakistan (2018).

The Department has been providing state of the art Orthopaedic services to the patients coming from all over Pakistan. The Orthopaedic procedures include Trauma, Arthroplasty, Pediatrics, Deformity correction and Arthroscopies. The 70-bedded Department comprises of 4 elective and 1 emergency operation theatre. The work load is managed by a unique team system comprising of a senior registrar, post-graduate trainees and house officers under supervision of a consultant Orthopaedic covering all stations including Outpatient department (OPD), emergency, wards and elective operation theatres round the clock. By doing so, all Orthopaedic patients were provided the Internationally required services. The operation theatres were upgraded to higher aseptic standards and the Infection rate was as per with the International standards and it was well appreciated by the Honorable Vice Chancellor, Administration, International and National Orthopaedic Community.

### **OVERVIEW**



The Department of Orthopaedics, Rawalpindi Medical University is conducting under- and post-graduate training programs, which include FCPS (Orthopaedic Surgery), MS (Orthopaedic Surgery), POA Trauma Fellowship, Doctor of Physical Therapy (DPT) and BS (Orthotics & Prosthetics). The Department is actively involved in educational activities, like the formation of curriculum, hands-on training workshops, seminars and symposias. Research has always been a major focus of attention for the Department. The Department has more than 50 International and National peer-reviewed publications.

The Department has collaboration with welfare societies like Pakistan Hemophilia Foundation and Pakistan Thalassaemia Welfare Society. The Department has a welfare program for the deserving non-affording patients, where they are provided implants arranged by the donor agencies, relatives of doctors, Zakat and Bait-ul-Maal. These patients are provided best quality imported implants. A system was evolved for the provision of best quality implants for the patients. The implant companies were accredited according to ISO and were registered with the Orthopaedic Department after taking consent from the administration.

### **COVID & ORTHOPAEDICS**



- COVID-19 identified potential infectious threat in China December 2019.
- 1<sup>st</sup> case reported in Pakistan 26<sup>th</sup> February 2020 (Karachi).
- Declared pandemic by the World Health Organization (WHO) 11<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
- Huge burden on health systems around the world.
- Impacted all aspects of medical practice.
- Specialities not directly related to its clinical effects such as orthopedic surgery.
- Elective surgical procedures postponed reduce the burden on health system.
- More availability of hospital beds.
- Management of emergent and urgent surgical cases affected.
- Solid understanding of the precautions required for resumption.


### **COVID & ORTHOPAEDICS**



- Drastic measures undertaken Social distancing to total lockdown.
- Economic & social affects.
- Patient population in need of hospitalization surpassing available resources.
- Risks posed by shortage of Personal Protective Equipment: non-traditional solutions developed (Reusable gowns, printed face-shields).
- Managing COVID-19 patients with surgical emergencies and trauma risk of self-infection higher degree of anxiety and depression.
- Online communication systems flourished.
- To provide meetings for faculty, quick and wide spread of knowledge, & outreach to patients through Telehealth systems.

## SYSTEM OF TRIAGE FOR COVID BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ORTHOPAEDICS





#### **COVID & ORTHOPAEDICS**



#### **Operating Room Measures Taken: -**

- Separate operating room (OR) designated for COVID-19 positive patients
- OR preferably Separate ventilation system with negative pressure or HEPA filters
- Air conditioning turned off
- C-Arm shifted to ER
- Materials necessary for case brought to the OR
- All equipment and screens covered with plastic sheets facilitate decontamination
- Cleaning with surface disinfectants & Ultraviolet light
- Traffic in and out of the OR minimized
- Patient recovered in the operating room & transferred directly to isolation ward
- Number of personnel inside the OR kept to the minimum

#### **COVID & ORTHOPAEDICS**

#### **Operating Room Measures Taken: -**

- Fewest number of personnel in OR.
- Highest skilled surgeon performed the procedure to avoid prolongation of surgery.
- All personnel in the operating room should wear the PPE surgical gowns, surgical hood (for head and neck covering), double gloves, facemasks either N95, Filtering Face Piece 2 (FFP2) respirators with a face shield/goggles.

#### Anaesthesia:

- Dedicated anesthesia machines exclusively designated for COVID-19 positive cases
- Most experienced anesthesiologist Intubate the patient in the shortest possible time
- Minimal airway manipulation, avoiding face mask ventilation and open-air way suction as possible
- Preferably avoid general anesthesia & use of regional/spinal anesthesia whenever possible

#### **Surgical Procedure:**

- Use of minimally invasive approaches Decrease operating staff exposure & shorten case duration
- Disposable medical instruments used whenever possible
- Absorbable sutures for wound closure avoid a postoperative unnecessary visit
- Use of electrocautery reduced to minimize the surgical smoke
- Use of power tools like bone saws, reamers, and drills reduced to minimum and the power settings as low as possible release aerosols, increase the risk of virus spread.




#### ANNUAL REPORT 2020 OUT PATIENT DEPARTMENT (OPD) BBH


