Step Ahead Welfare Society is a self-financed, non-political organization established by students from RMU and run by students of other as well. From the past 5 years (being established in 2018). SAWS has been working to impart education in the kids of slums of Rawalpindi by teaching them 5 days a week at Liaquat bagh,

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

We believe that every child has the right to get educated- a right they shall not be denied. We work with the aim of changing the perspective of people who think that education is a luxury and not a necessity by making it accessible to as many kids as possible.

The Society runs a street school in Liaquatbagh 5 days a week throughout the year where 50+ kids from the slums of Mareer Hasan and Arya Mohalla are being taught free of cost. Other than this camp, important activities throughout the year include

1. School admissions

27 kids are already enrolled in schools and 23 new admissions are in process.

2. Eid fest 18 - 28th April 2022

Eid fest covering 8 orphanages and 2 old homes of twin cities was arranged where eid gifts and ration was presented. Donations collected for this fest were Rs. **74,390.**

3. Community drives

Community drives are conducted to discuss the problems of kids with their parents and raise awareness about education at Arya Mohalla and Marrir. A total of 4 community drives were conducted dated 27th Aug 2021, 16th Jan 2022, 26th Aug 2022 and 17th Oct 2022.

4. Awareness sessions for kids

1. Self Defense sessions ... a total of 4 sessions from 14th to 21st Oct 2021
2. Climate change awareness session -6th Nov 2022 (collaborative event with YLCians)
3. Dengue Awareness session along with sports for the kids 13th Nov 2021 (Collaborative event with OHEC and THP)
4. Independence day, Eid Milad un Nabi, Iqbals Day celebrations with the intent to familiarize the kids with importance of each event.
5. Session on Good and Bad Touch 15th Oct 2022 (Collaborative event with TVS)

5. Capacity building sessions for volunteers

A series of get together are arranged for the volunteers to teach them effective teaching methodologies and strategies by the expert teachers.
