Following our aim, we always strive to arrange healthy and fresh blood for deserving patients. More than 90 percent of our blood donation is for the poor Thalassemic patients. Apart from Thalassemia we also arrange blood for any emergency cases in the hospitals. We are working on developing an android blood application.

- 639 Blood Bags collected at these blood camps

  - Fresh donors from RMU were 252


