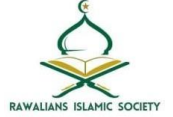

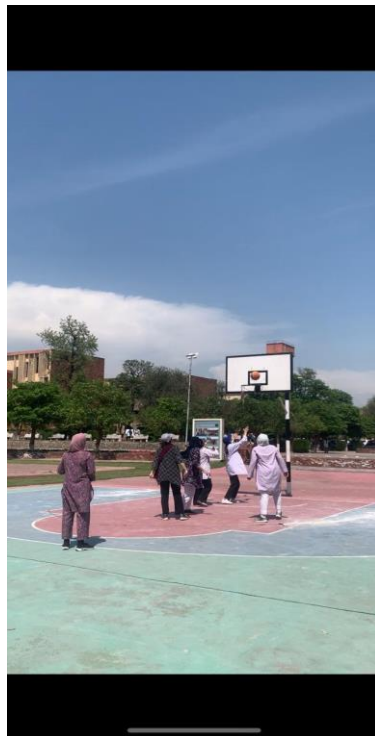

### Feedback:

Overall, the events were quite successful, the audience was a bit off due to heat and timings of opening ceremony. But that got sorted by the time we got to closing ceremony. We had a bustling response in the closing ceremony. The key issues we had were that the ground was not ready by prep week. This was the major spanner in the works heading into sports week. But I will explain that further in a detailed audit report.

### Simple Audit:

So, the full budget we got for Rawalian Sports Society was 292,198. Simple breakdown of the budget was as follows:

1. Opening ceremony expenses:
  - Band booking: 15,000.
  - Archery booth: 16,000.
  - Decorations: 25,000.
  - Balloons for Pana flex flying: 15,000 (200 balloons).
  - Professional Cameramen: 20,000.
2. Enclosure Building: (Enclosure stuff and props)
  - First Year to fourth year: 60,000 (15kx4)
  - Final year: 25,000.
3. Badminton Booking: 24,000 (6k an hour)
4. Swimming Booking: 26,000 (1300 per person for 2 hours)
5. Snooker Booking: 22,000.
6. eSports Cost: 11,000 (renting four controller and one ps4)
7. Daily refreshment cost: 30,000 (10 days and 3k a day)
8. Sports Accessories not covered in tender:

- Volleyball net: 2500
  - Chess board: 2300
  - Jenga for girls: 2800
  - Badminton and Table tennis accessories: 3000
9. Miscellaneous Costs (Petrol for bringing the stuff, Powder for football markings, carrom board powder, ludo boards):
- Transport expenses: 5000.
  - Powder for football: 1500
  - Powder for carrom: 500
  - Ludo boards: 800
  - Camera For closing ceremony: 8,000.
  - Batch of the year trophy: 5000

**Grand Total: 320,400.**

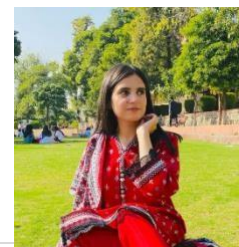

Later, approval of a Colonel was also taken. Equipment was also inspected by the presidents to ensure compliance with the safety standards. Additionally, all students were allowed to enter the university by showing their ID card issued by the university.
