



MEDICINE SECTION

It is the most enthusiastically working section of MAS and aims at providing free medical care to those who either don't have access to it or can't afford it. This section besides having free dispensary at office for medical students, university employees and deserving patients, also arranges free medical camps in remote areas of Rawalpindi and Islamabad with scarce medical facilities. At our medical camps, consultants, registrars and medical officers from our teaching hospitals provide free check up facilities and free screening against viral diseases and medicines of reputed pharmaceuticals. Along with that Public Awareness sessions on common health problems are also conducted. It also arranges vaccination camps against Hepatitis B for RMU students and maintains medical boxes in both girls and boys hostels.




