# **MISSION STATEMENT**

To continuously strive for improvement in Healthcare Services, and to ensure that these services are not only accessible to all but are also safe, effective and efficient.

## **GLIMPSE OF HOLY FAMILY HOSPITAL, RAWALPINDI**

Holy Family Hospital was established in the year 1927 by the Christian Mission of Philadelphia at Muree Road Rawalpindi. It was designed by an Italian Architect (a prisoner of World War II).

The hospital was shifted to the present building situated in Satellite Town, F Block, Rawalpindi in 1946-47. It was assumed control by Punjab Government in 1977 and affiliated with Rawalpindi Medical College as a Teaching Hospital. Initially bed strength was 200 beds and later it was raised to 450 beds. Initially there were Departments of Surgery, Medicine, Ophthalmology and Gynecology/Obstetrics, later on, the Department of Paramedics, Pediatrics, Radiology, Pathology and Dentistry were added.

In 1997, the plan for the construction of the new block was completed and construction work started. It is a C-Shaped four story building around the old building. In the year 2000 most of the civil works were completed and most of the departments were started shifting to this new building with most modern and sophisticated facilities. Hence the hospital was expanded and officially started functioning.

The new building has been facilitated with elevators and ramps to facilitate the patients.

The new block is now fully operational. It is equipped with the latest equipment including MRI and DRA (Biplane Digital Subtraction Angiography) and these were installed in 2005. Holy Family Hospital was granted autonomy in June 1998, and it was declared as an Autonomous Hospital on **July 1**st **1998**.

Hospital is fully equipped with the latest medical equipment. Holy Family Hospital, Rawalpindi have well-equipped Operation Theaters having the latest facilities of Motorized Operation Tables, Closed Circuit TV, Ceiling Suspended System comprising of Operating Microscope, Patient Monitors, Anesthesia Apparatus and Ventilators.

The Surgical Department plays a major role in the research activities and has participated in National and International Research Activities. Surgical Unit-II has played a pioneering role in introducing the concept of Telemedicine in Pakistan. Its initiative was taken in 1998 and faculty has been trained in multiple centers of USA.

This hospital has the distinction that its Medical Unit-I has been selected as the first center of Diagnosis and treatment of Hepatitis (B and C) under the Prime Minister's Hepatitis Control Program.

Rawalian Burn Unit was set up in 2006 having its separate ICU.

Separate ICUs were made for Medical and Surgical Departments. There is also a separate CCU available.

School of Midwifery / General Nursing is also working in this institute and hundreds of students are being trained every year. Nursing School has been upgraded as College of Nursing since 2016 and is now shifted to the new building. BSN / Post RN Nursing have also been started in this college. In near future B.Sc Generic will also be started.

Diagnostic facilities of Radiology and Pathology are also available in the hospital.

A laundry plant was also installed.

A new central supply and sterilization department is now functioning. Blood bank and Thalassemia Center is also present.

The hospital has Central Air Conditioning System (HVAC). Human Resource Development Committee has been formed. Nephrology unit has also been established in the year 2007.

## **RADIOLOGY:**



## D. MAJOR PROBLEMS:

# **Major Problems**

#### ► HUMAN RESOURCE ISSUES:

➤ Since the year 2015, the hospital has not made any recruitment due to which the hospital is facing acute shortage of human resource i.e. Doctors, Nurses, Paramedical and Support Staff almost in every department of the Hospital. At present Vacancy position is as under:

## **▶** Nurses

The sanction strength of charge nurses in this hospital is 482 but at present only about 452 nurses are working while the requirement of the hospital is far above from the sanction strength as most of the time the hospital has to hire charge nurses from Rawalpindi Institute of Urology and Transplantation, Rawalpindi to meet the requirements of the hospital. Moreover, the charge nurses are proceeding abroad after directly getting Ex-Pakistan Leave which is also a source of shortage of staff.

The sanction strength of Head Nurses is 71, while at present only 39 Head Nurses are working. The hospital is also facing severe shortage of Head Nurses as each Head Nurse is supervising almost 5 departments.

- ► Shortage of Funds for repair & maintenance of Equipment.
- ▶ Shortage of Biomedical Technicians as per Yard Stick of Hospital.
- ▶ Shortage of High Tech equipment due to which available equipment is overburdened.
- ▶ Due to outage of Trained ICUs Nursing Staff, the operationalization faults of equipment has increased too much.

#### **EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT:**

► The number of patients visiting Emergency is increasing day by day along with increase in work load while the human resources is very limited specially the lower support staff which needs to be increased to improve the quality care of patients. ER Department needs to be upgraded to increase the bed capacity and other facilities like OTs and new equipment

### **▶** DIALYSIS MACHINES:

- ► 24/7 services provided.
- ▶ 10 dialysis machines are installed only 05 machines are nonfunctional at Holy Family Hospital, Rawalpindi on donation basis but are not enough for such large number of patients visiting hospital.
- ▶ Inadequate allocation of funds for dialysis / medicines and other services.

#### **GENERAL PROBLEMS:**

- ► Hospital has a Dental Department but it is not recognized and does not have proper seats and training facilities.
- ▶ Budget allocation for purchase of surgical instruments, repair of equipment is insufficient.
- ► Need of installation / repair of incinerators.
- ► Need of New HVAC.
- ▶ Deficiency of exhaust system in basement of old building.

# **ACHIEVEMENTS**

- ► Strategic Revamping of whole Holy Family Hospital, Rawalpindi including old & new building completed Oct, 2024.
- ▶ Following hospital furniture/Equipment and air conditioning units has been provided by SHC & ME, Lahore worth 661 million after the completion of revamping of Holy Family Hospital, Rawalpindi.

- ► New Ac's are provided and installed.
- ▶ 1Boiler in revamping process will be completed in coming week.
- ▶ 30 AUH of HVAC in overhauling has been completed in recent revamping work.
- ► Renovation of Hospital.
- ▶ Before revamping of Holy Family Hospital, Rawalpindi Biomedical department uninstalled all the biomedical equipment in a safe & smooth manner and packed the equipment in safe storage areas.
- ► Preserved all the High tech biomedical equipment like C.T scan Machine, X Raya machines, Autoclaves, Modular O.Ts before revamping.
- ► Preserved All the Biomedical Gases Plant Room and machinery like Air and Vacuum Compressor Units.
- ► Shifted & Installed the essential biomedical equipment in BBH, RTH, RIU, Red Crescent Hospitals for manage patient work load.
- ▶ Redesigned the Biomedical Gases routing in all the departments of Hospital for provision of biomedical gases.
- ► Supervised the installation work of 14 Modular O.T in new Building and installation work of biomedical gases in old & new Building.
- ► Commissioning work of biomedical gas piping in new & old building.
- ► Supervised the installation & Commissioning work of New Oxygen Generation Plant Donated by UNDP in Holy Family Hospital.

- ▶ After completion of Revamping work in Hospital, Biomedical department re-Installed all the equipment in ICU's, OT's, Wards, Emergency and other departments.
- ➤ Shifter back the biomedical equipment from other Hospitals RTH, BBH, and RIU & Red Crescent in their respective revamped areas.
- ► Re-functioning of CT scan Machine, Air & Vacuum Plants.
- ► Condemnation of outdated Biomedical Equipment & Hospital Furniture/items as per direction of Govt.
- ► Successful Auctions of all the condemned items as per direction of Govt.
- ► Shifting of Hospital Furniture and Equipment from Warehouse of TCS in Lahore to Holy Family Hospital as per direction of Govt.
