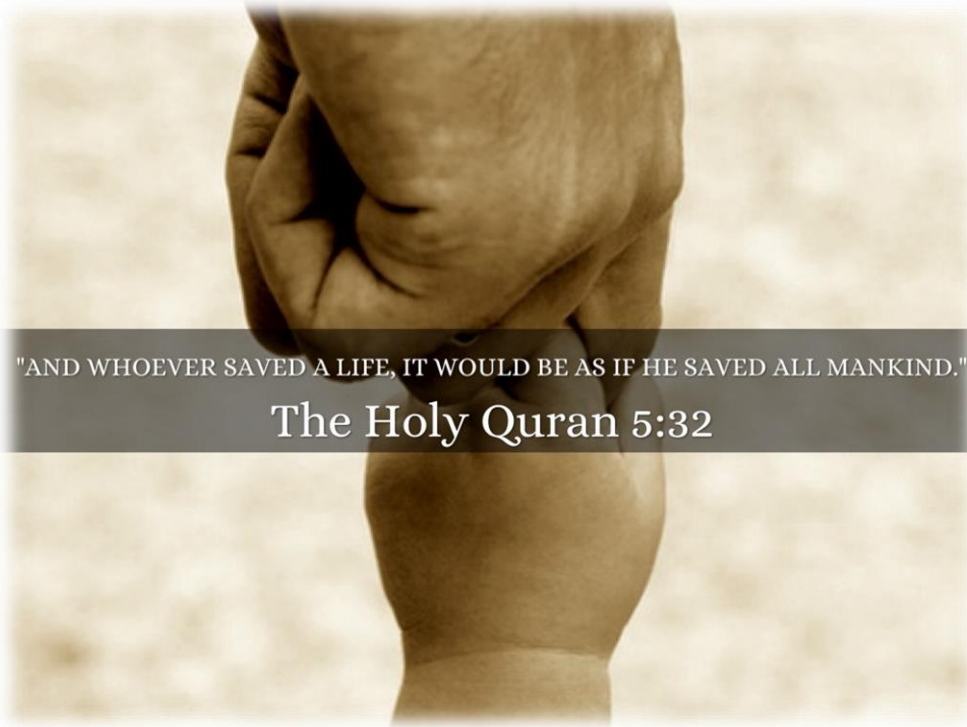

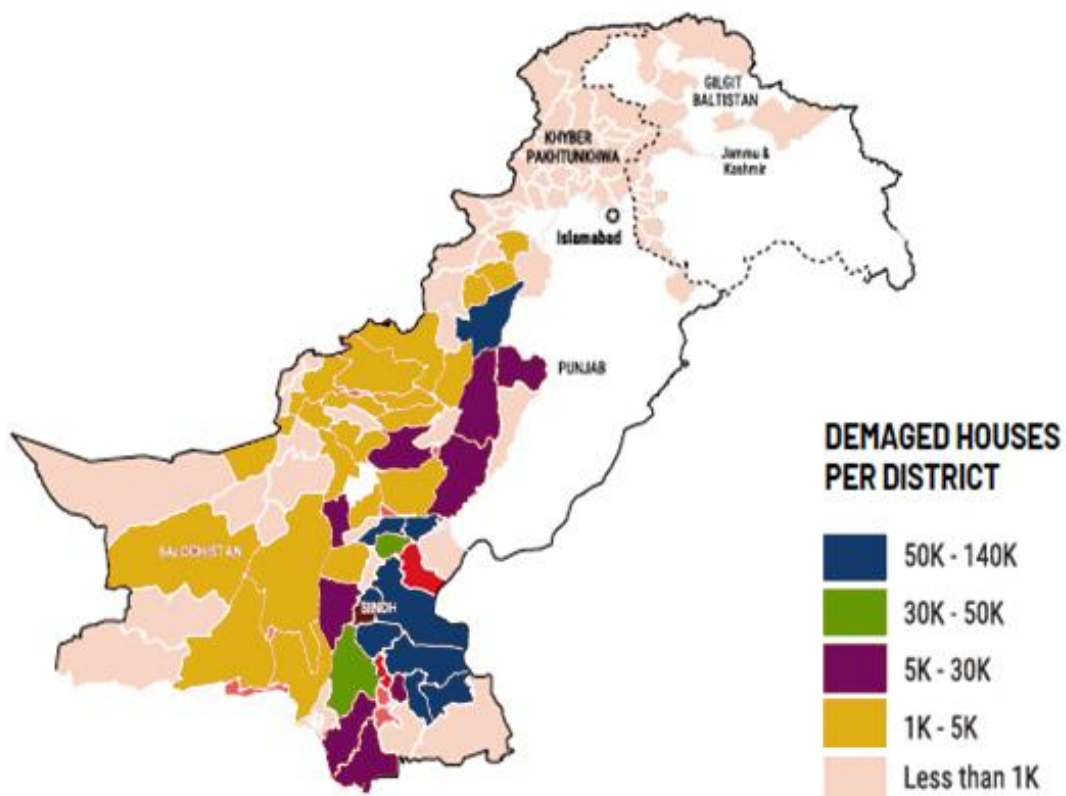
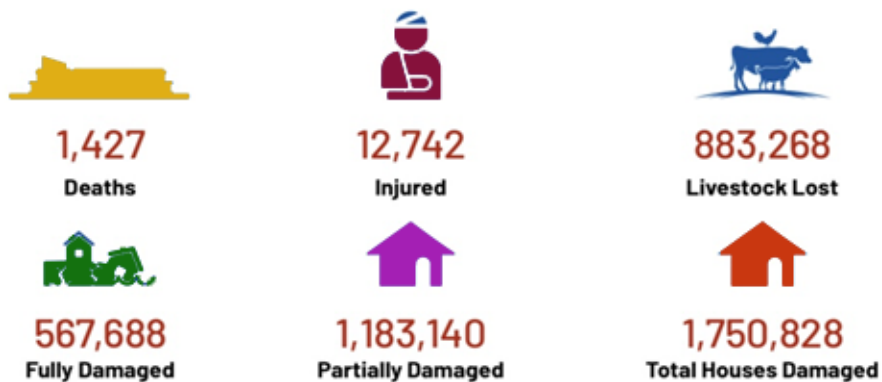
Extreme monsoon rains have caused the worst floods in Pakistan's recent history, destroying communities and at heightened danger of waterborne infections, drowning, and starvation. Hundreds of thousands of houses have been destroyed, along with several public health institutions, water infrastructure, and schools. More than 664,000 people have taken refuge in displacement camps, with many needing basic housing, food, water, and sanitation.

Rawalpindi Medical University (RMU) activated its Flood Relief Action Program led by Prof. Dr. Muhammad Umar (S.I), Vice Chancellor, RMU. The Program comprised of organizing free medical camps in South Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Sindh and Balochistan. A book on Post Flood Community Health Guidelines has especially been published by RMU in collaboration with Higher Education Commission (HEC) of Pakistan to guide the community and healthcare workers on preventing and managing waterborne infections.

It is for the first time that a practical initiative in the form of "Ready RMU – Preventive Kit" and "Ready RMU – Hygiene Kit" for the prevention of Malaria and Gastroenteritis have been prepared in huge numbers and are being distributed in all the flood affected areas to prevent waterborne infections.

Devastation of Floods in Pakistan

As a result of continuing monsoon rains and floods, 81 of the 116 worst-affected districts have been designated disaster-stricken. Sindh, Balochistan, and South Punjab have been notably afflicted, although Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KPK) and Gilgit Baltistan have also been severely impacted. According to the NDMA, this has significant consequences for human lives, property, infrastructure, livelihood, and livestock impacting 33 million people.

On the directions of Health Department, Government of the Punjab, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Umar (S.I) called an emergency meeting of RMU faculty and comprised an RMU Flood Relief Action Committee.

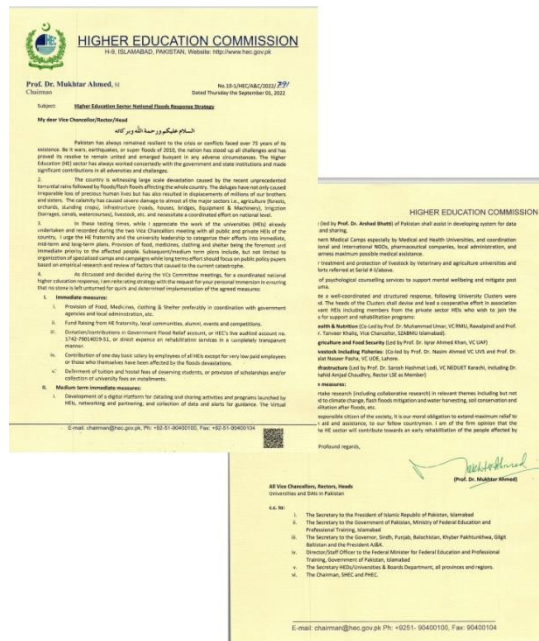
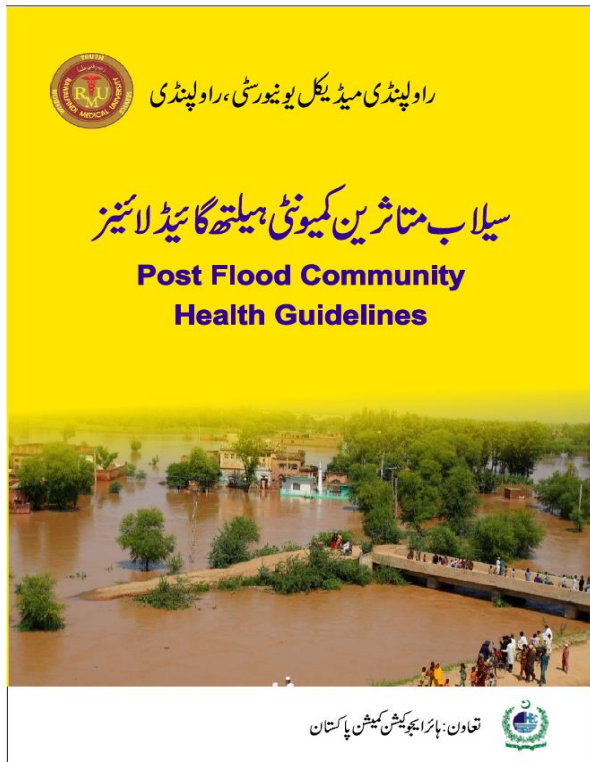

RMU Post Flood Community Health Guidelines


The devastating flood not only took the human lives, destroyed infrastructures, crops, veterinary but left no clean drinking water and safe food for the flood affectees. After the first challenge, the second was disease epidemics like gastroenteritis, malaria, dengue, etc. fearing thousands of deaths of the most vulnerable children and pregnant women. RMU took the lead to launch prevention campaigns to avoid these epidemics. The Department of Community Medicine and help of other experts, RMU developed the first guidelines for the general public in urdu.

Chairman HEC nominated Vice Chancellor RMU (Prof. Dr. Muhammad Umar) and SZAIBMU (Prof. Dr. Tanveer Khaliq) to launch campaigns for Health and Nutrition during the devastating floods.



Ready RMU – Preventive Kit

As a measure of prophylaxis against Gastroenteritis and Malaria, RMU prepared its own medical kits by the name of “Ready RMU – Prevention Kit”. It is for the first time globally, that such an initiative has been taken. These kits are being distributed in large numbers all across the country in flood affected areas.

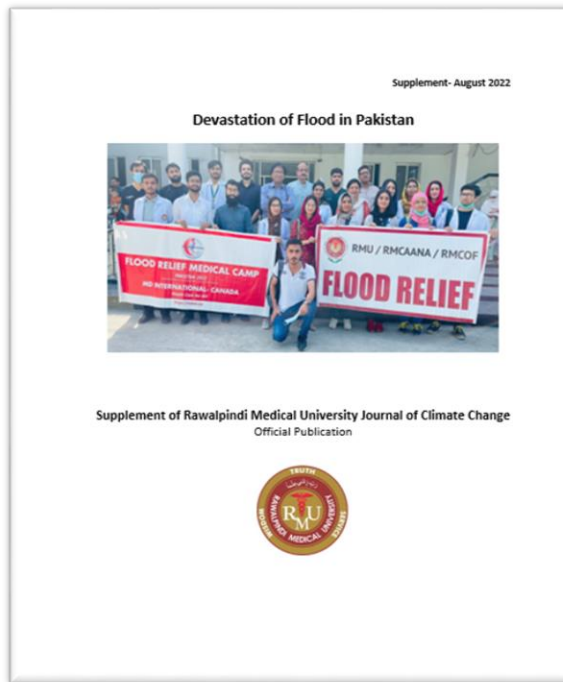
