Off-Campus Online LMS Assessment Policy 2026

The weightage for Off-Campus Online LMS Assessment has been revised from 2025 to 2026 to incorporate new components for Research and Artificial Intelligence (AI). For most years, the original 10% weightage for off-campus LMS in 2025 has been split into a 5% LMS component and a 5% Research/AI component for 2026.

The following table summarizes the comparison across all years of the MBBS program:


- **Weightage Shift:** In 2025, the Off-Campus component was primarily focused on Summative LMS assessments (10% weightage). In 2026, this 10% block (or 5% in the case of Final Year) was divided to include Research and AI to modernize the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) framework.
- **Research & AI Integration:** For the first four years, the 5% Research/AI block is generally split as 3% for Research and 2% for AI. In Final Year, it is split as 2% Research and 1% AI, with the remaining 2% allocated to evening LMS assessments.
- **Assessment Methods:**
 - Research is assessed through Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) such as synopsis approval, data collection, and manuscript submission.

- AI is assessed through specific KPIs like history taking on AI platforms (e.g., HUMA) or completion of designated AI courses and activity reports.
